4 simple steps to Kick for Children with Cancer

1. Register for your free event pack

- Sign up online at www.clicsargent.org.uk/football
- Call us on 08451 20 22 32
- Complete the form on the back of this leaflet and post it to the address provided.

2. Decide what event you want to hold

You could hold a sponsored penalty shoot-out, a football fun day, a mini-tournament – or any other football event you like. If you prefer not to have a sponsored event, you could dedicate a match or tournament and ask anyone who wants to play to bring £1. Our free pack has plenty of ideas to help you choose. We suggest you hold your event some time between April and August but if another date suits you better, feel free to hold it then.

3. Start fundraising!

Give your young footballers plenty of time to get sponsored. The more they raise, the greater the difference they'll make to the lives of children with cancer. You could also ask your pupils to think about other ways they could raise money in advance or on the day.

Remember – your school, club or organisation can keep 25% of the money you raise.

4. Hold your event

You'll find everything you need in your free event pack, including stickers, a media guide to help you get local publicity and details of how to order free footballs if you need them.

Billy's story

Billy's parents first noticed something wrong in the summer holidays, when he seemed to be tired all the time and was quieter than usual. The following February he started to cough. His mother, Eve, tells us:



“His cough didn't stop him wanting to play football for his local team at a cup match but when he ran on to the pitch he could hardly play.

“I explained to the GP that he had been tired and that his chesty cough hadn't cleared. We were referred to the hospital next day for tests. I could tell something was wrong by the reaction of the doctors. Then they told us Billy had leukaemia. There aren't words to describe how that felt.

“We met Gemma, our CLIC Sargent Social Worker, when Billy transferred to another hospital. She helped us get a £200 care grant to help with travelling and parking costs.



I could stay in a nice, homely environment and still be within walking distance of the hospital.

“Billy has dealt with his treatment in a really mature way and he's been back to school as much as he can. He hasn't played football since

his diagnosis but he's really enjoying watching matches – especially the Cup Final.”
